## OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN DECISION

### **ABOUT ADDITIONAL MEASURES TO SUPPORT CITIZENS OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN AND THEIR FAMILY MEMBERS WHO ARE TEMPORARILY WORKING ABROAD**

Within the framework of the system of safe, orderly and legal labor migration introduced in our country, we are consistent in teaching foreign languages and professions to citizens going abroad, protecting their rights and interests abroad, providing the necessary social and information-advisory assistance, and providing comprehensive support to their family members. work is being done.

At the same time, there is a need to increase the level of legal protection of labor migrants abroad, to systematically study and solve their problems in the workplace, and to inform them about the reforms and positive changes implemented in Uzbekistan.

In order to further strengthen the legal protection of citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan who are temporarily working abroad and to expand the system of social and economic support for their family members:

1. From June 1, 2022, the representative institute of the Foreign Labor Migration Agency under the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations (hereinafter - the representative) should be introduced in the territories of the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Republic of Kazakhstan indicated in Appendix 1.

Note that:

at least two representatives will be assigned to each region specified in Appendix 1 to this decision;

representatives are accredited in the Russian Federation - as employees of the agency of the Foreign Labor Migration Agency under the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations in Moscow, in the Republic of Turkey and the Republic of Kazakhstan - as administrative and technical employees of diplomatic missions and consular institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan in these countries;

one of the representatives is selected from among highly qualified specialists who have stable experience of working in foreign countries and is sent from the Republic of Uzbekistan, and the other is recruited from among reputable, broad-minded compatriots living in a foreign country or other persons with the necessary qualifications and experience;

Representatives selected in the Republic of Uzbekistan will be sent on a long-term service trip to the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Republic of Kazakhstan;

the activities of representatives are mainly organized in foreign enterprises or educational institutions where a large number of citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan are engaged in organized labor activities;

coordination of the activities of representatives in foreign countries is carried out by the heads of diplomatic missions and consular institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan;

the position of representative will be introduced to increase the number of employees of the Foreign Labor Migration Agency;

The Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations, in agreement with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, has the right to combine or reduce the number of representatives to other regions within the limits of the number of their states limited by this decision.

2. The following should be designated as the main activities of the representative:

To protect the rights and interests of the citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan who are temporarily working abroad in cooperation with the diplomatic missions and consular institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan, to support them materially and socially;

establishing and strengthening close ties with compatriots abroad and Uzbek national-cultural organizations, regularly organizing cultural and spiritual-educational events for labor migrants in cooperation with them;

Carrying out comprehensive propaganda and explanation work among the citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan living abroad about the socio-economic reforms implemented in Uzbekistan, privileges and opportunities created for citizens;

Expanding the scope of organized employment of citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan abroad, preventing illegal labor migration, conducting negotiations with potential employers;

assistance to the citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan who were subjected to violence, forced labor and humiliation, were injured, had an unfortunate incident, had a serious illness, fell into a difficult financial situation, were left without identity documents or without funds during their stay abroad;

providing information and advice to the citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan who are temporarily working abroad about the services provided by the diplomatic missions, consular institutions, labor bodies and migration centers of the Republic of Uzbekistan, and assisting them in using these services.

3. It should be noted that the material and financial support for the activities of representatives, including paying them wages, covering their business travel and living expenses in a foreign country, as well as providing them with transport, service buildings, means of communication and other necessary equipment:

in 2022 from the funds of the fund for supporting citizens working abroad and protecting their rights and interests under the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations;

Starting from 2023, according to the justified calculations of the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations, it will be carried out annually from the budget funds allocated to the fund for the support of citizens working abroad and the protection of their rights and interests.

In this case, the funds for the material and financial support of the representatives in the Republic of Turkey and the Republic of Kazakhstan will be transferred to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

The Ministry of Finance (T. Ishmetov) should consider allocating necessary funds to the fund for the support of citizens working abroad and protection of their rights and interests in order to finance the expenses related to the organization of the activities of representatives in the formation of the parameters of the state budget for 2023 and the following years.

4. Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan (A. Bekmurodov), Ministry of Foreign Affairs (A. Kamilov), Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations (E. Mukhitdinov) together with:

By May 1, 2022, organize training seminars for representatives to explain the essence and content of the newly introduced system;

to attract employees of the ministry, offices, local governments and other organizations with sufficient skills and experience to the training-seminars.

It should be noted that the expenses related to the organization of educational seminars are covered from the funds of the fund for the support of citizens working abroad and the protection of their rights and interests.

5. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs (A. Kamilov) together with the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations (E. Mukhitdinov):

create the necessary conditions for organizing the activities of representatives, including providing practical assistance in providing service rooms and material and technical equipment (furniture, computer sets, tablets, communication, Internet, etc.);

take measures to attract reputable, broad-minded compatriots or other persons with necessary skills and experience as representatives;

to help the representatives in establishing relations with local authorities, law enforcement agencies and other institutions, as well as Uzbek national and cultural organizations and compatriots in the foreign countries where they operate;

To establish permanent cooperation with representatives on the issues of employment of citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan in foreign countries, providing legal, material and social assistance to labor migrants;

establish strict control over the correct distribution and targeted spending of the funds allocated for the material and financial support of the representatives' activities.

6. The "road map" for legal, social, cultural and educational support of citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan abroad should be approved in accordance with Appendix 2 .

Let the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations (E. Mukhitdinov) together with other ministries and agencies ensure timely, complete and high-quality implementation of the measures provided for in the "road map".

7. From May 1, 2022, the Federation of Trade Unions of Uzbekistan will annually:

a) based on the written recommendation of district (city) governors' assistants (hereinafter referred to as governor's assistants) on the issues of developing entrepreneurship in the neighborhood, ensuring employment of the population, and reducing poverty:

providing one-time financial assistance in the amount of 2 times the amount of the basic calculation to families whose breadwinner has gone abroad for labor migration and is registered in the information system of the "Single Register of Social Protection";

Medicines, wheelchairs, hearing aids and orthopedic products for disabled family members who are registered in the information system of the "Single Register of Social Protection" or entered in one of the "Iron Register", "Women's Register" and "Youth Register"

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one-time financial assistance in the amount of 5 times the amount of the basic calculation for purchase;

providing a one-time free ticket to sanatoriums and preventive treatment facilities in the system of trade unions to family members of citizens who have gone on labor migration who have reached retirement age or have group I and II disabilities living with them in the Republic of Uzbekistan;

b) to give free tickets to the children of citizens who have gone on labor migration and who are registered in the "Unified Register of Social Protection" information system or included in one of the "Temir daftar", "Ayollar daftari" and "Yoshlar daftari" and who have left for labor migration, based on the written recommendation of the youth leaders in the neighborhoods. support the initiative.

8. It should be noted that the funds of the Federation of Trade Unions of Uzbekistan provide allowances and vouchers to the family members of citizens who have gone on labor migration:

a) allowances and referrals are provided if the citizens who went on labor migration are registered in the "Labor migration" program complex;

b) applicants apply electronically to the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations through the "Labor migration" software package to receive allowances and referrals;

c) Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations:

within five days from the date of receipt of the electronic application from the applicants, they will check whether they respond to the requirements considered in paragraph 7 of this decision, without asking for additional documents, based on the information received from other ministries and departments through electronic information exchange, and will receive a written recommendation from the governor's assistants and youth leaders in the neighborhoods;

forms a list of applicants who meet the requirements considered in paragraph 7 of this decision and submits it to the Federation of Trade Unions of Uzbekistan by the 25th of each month.

9. Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations (E. Mukhitdinov) until May 1, 2022:

Together with the Ministry of Economic Development and Poverty Alleviation and the Youth Affairs Agency, integrate the "Labor migration" software package with the information systems developed for governor's assistants and the "Youth Portal" electronic platform;

In the "Labor migration" program complex, create a special page that provides the opportunity to use the assistance provided to the family members of labor migrants by the Federation of Trade Unions of Uzbekistan.

10. District (city) mayors, assistant mayors, youth leaders in neighborhoods and neighborhood heads regularly:

to find out about the status of the family members of the citizens who went on labor migration, study their problems and needs and help them solve them, as well as carry out appropriate work to improve their material, social and living conditions;

to study the interests of the family members of the citizens who went on labor migration, to take measures to direct them to vocational and entrepreneurship training centers, and to help ensure the employment of the graduates who have completed their studies;

provide practical assistance to the family members of citizens who have gone on labor migration in crafting, homemaking, effective use of land, small production, service and other types of activities, as well as in obtaining loans within the framework of entrepreneurship programs;

to connect with the citizens who went on labor migration through the Internet and other means of communication with the participation of their family members, organize conversations and together with the Foreign Labor Migration Agency take the necessary measures to solve the problems of these citizens identified as a result of the conversation;

to solve the problems of the children of citizens who have gone to labor migration, to organize their free time in a meaningful way, to encourage their talents and initiatives, to involve them widely in national folk games, sports competitions, youth festivals and other cultural and educational events.

The Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, regional and Tashkent city governments should provide the Cabinet of Ministers with consolidated information on the work carried out in these directions every month.

11. Youth Affairs Agency (A. Sadullaev), Ministry of Foreign Affairs (A. Kamilov), Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations (E. Mukhitdinov), Ministry of Information Technologies and Communications Development (Sh. Shermatov) in cooperation with the Youth Union of Uzbekistan:

In order to provide targeted support to Uzbek youth who are temporarily working and studying abroad, form the "Balance of Youth Abroad" and enter the necessary information

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about them into the "Youth Portal" electronic platform;

Together with diplomatic missions and consular institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan, organize mobile receptions for young Uzbeks who are abroad;

Take necessary measures to solve the identified problems and needs of Uzbek youth during the formation of the "Balance of Youth Abroad" and conducting mobile receptions.

The Youth Affairs Agency (A. Saadullaev) should make proposals to the Cabinet of Ministers about changes and additions to the legislation resulting from the measures set forth in this paragraph within two months.

12. Establish such an order that, in accordance with it:

From March 1, 2022, the microloans considered in paragraph 11 of the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated September 15, 2020 "On measures to introduce a system of safe, orderly and legal labor migration" No. PK- 4829 "Temir Daftar", "Women's Daftar" or it is also paid to citizens who are included in one of the "Youth registers" and go abroad for temporary labor activities through organized labor migration;

**Compensations** for passing qualification exams, purchasing a road ticket and issuing a "working visa" provided for in the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated July 30, 2021 "On additional measures to encourage citizens going on organized labor migration abroad" It will be paid by January 1.

13. Heads of diplomatic missions and consular institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Republic of Kazakhstan should take measures to establish direct and open communication with citizens abroad, including:

to regularly organize mobile meetings and roundtable discussions in foreign enterprises or educational institutions where a large number of citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan are engaged in organized labor activities;

to regularly hold "Open Doors Day" in order to acquaint citizens living abroad with the main activities of the diplomatic mission and consular institution;

prepare video materials showing positive examples from the life of labor migrants and their heroic deeds and ensure that they are covered at least once a month in foreign mass media.

14. Amendments and additions should be made to some decisions of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan in accordance with Appendix 3 .

15. The Minister of Foreign Affairs A.H. is responsible and personally responsible for the effective organization of the implementation of this decision. Kamilov, first deputy minister of employment and labor relations E.M. Mukhitdinov and adviser to the Prime Minister of the Republic of Uzbekistan M.A. Let Khairiddinov be identified.

Quarterly information should be submitted to the Administration of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on the effectiveness of the implemented measures.

a) in the fourth column of paragraph 3, the words "by agreement with the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations" shall be replaced by the words "by the head of the Foreign Labor Migration Agency in agreement with the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations";

b) after the words "recognized" in the second line of paragraph 11, the words "or included in one of the "Iron Book", "Women's Book", "Youth Book" shall be added;

c) The words "Samara, Ufa, Shymkent and Istanbul" in the fourth heading of paragraph 13 should be replaced by the words "Samara and Ufa".

3. Paragraph 2 of the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated July 30, 2021 "On additional measures to encourage citizens going on organized labor migration abroad" No. PK - 5205 :

The first letter should be stated in the following version:

"Let it be established that, according to it, from September 1, 2021 until December 31, 2022, the support of citizens working abroad and the protection of their rights and interests (hereinafter referred to as the Fund) will be registered in the program complex "Labor-migration" to citizens who have passed and are leaving for organized labor migration:";

the word "or" in the second paragraph should be replaced by the words "and (or)".

4. Resolution No. 725 of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated September 12, 2018 "On measures to further improve and radically revise the system of organized employment of citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan abroad " :

a) Appendix 1 :

The word "ten" in paragraph 11 should be replaced by the word "twenty";

The number "3" in paragraph 53 should be replaced by the word "thirty";

b) in paragraph 23 of Appendix 4 :

The first letter should be stated in the following version:

"The agency is headed by a head appointed by the Minister of Employment and Labor Relations of the Republic of Uzbekistan in agreement with the Cabinet of Ministers. The head of the agency will be dismissed from his position by the Minister of Employment and Labor Relations of the Republic of Uzbekistan";

The eighth letter should be stated in the following version:

"In agreement with the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations of the Republic of Uzbekistan, appoints and dismisses the heads of regional branches of the Agency, pre-departure adaptation and training centers for citizens going abroad, heads of departments and employees, as well as heads of foreign representative offices of the Agency in agreement with the Cabinet of Ministers";

The tenth paragraph should be stated in the following version:

"The head of the agency has three deputies, including one first deputy, appointed by the Minister of Employment and Labor Relations of the Republic of Uzbekistan in agreement with the Cabinet of Ministers. The deputy heads of the agency will be dismissed from their positions by the Minister of Employment and Labor Relations";

c) Appendix 5 :

The seventh letter of paragraph 6 should be amended as follows:

To pay the expenses of successfully passed qualification exams in foreign languages and (or) to the citizens who are registered in the "Labor-migration" program complex and are going to labor migration in an organized selection procedure, to pay compensation for the purchase of a road transport ticket for going abroad";

Clause 6 should be filled with the twelfth letter of the following content:

"Sending Agency employees on long-term service trips to foreign countries and financing the activities of persons recruited as representatives of the Agency in foreign countries";

In the scheme of organizing the spending of funds of the fund for supporting citizens working abroad and protecting their rights and interests under the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations of the Republic of Uzbekistan in accordance with the approved directions :

Item 6 "Directions of using funds of the Fund" should be stated in the following version:

To pay the expenses of successfully passed qualification exams in foreign languages and (or) to the citizens who are registered in the "Labor-migration" program complex and are going to labor migration in an organized selection procedure, to pay compensation for the purchase of a road transport ticket for going abroad";

be filled with item 11 with the following content:

5. Clause 32 of the Regulation on the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations of the Republic of Uzbekistan, approved by the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers No. 1066 dated December 31, 2018 :

The fourth-sixth paragraphs should be stated in the following version:

"The Agency is headed by the Head of the Agency appointed by the Minister in agreement with the Cabinet of Ministers. The head of the agency is dismissed by the Minister.

The head of the agency will have three deputies, including one first deputy, who will be appointed by the Minister in agreement with the Cabinet of Ministers. Deputy heads of the agency are dismissed from their positions by the Minister.

The agency will have representative offices abroad. The head of the agency is appointed by the head of the agency in agreement with the Cabinet of Ministers.

Note: sub-paragraph "a" of clause 4 of this addendum shall come into force on June 1, 2022.
